What's new?

How Al-Anon Works (B-22, B-32): The latest printings of both the hard cover and soft cover editions now include a full description of “Didn’t cause, Can’t cure, Can’t control” (the “Three Cs”). It can be found on pages 16-17 of hardcover printings that have the number “11-11” in the bottom left corner of the copyright page, and in soft cover printings that have the number “12-2.”

“CAL Corner”: Each month, the “CAL Corner” feature in *The Forum* includes members’ sharings on a particular piece of our literature. September’s article celebrates the 50th anniversary of the pamphlet ***A Guide for the Family of the Alcoholic*** (P-7). The October article will be on ***How Al-Anon Works*** (B-22, B-32).
