

KBDM Presentation for Spring 2018 Assembly

15 minutes:

Give a short introduction to KBDM:

--Have 4 cheerleaders hold up the letters KBDM and do a cheer.

--At the 2006 World Service Conference, the Board defined the KBDM process as “looking at a topic through certain agreed-upon criteria to see if it is something that the group wants to pursue.” (It is not a process to find an answer.)

--The most important 3 words to remember about KBDM are: AGW (Assume Good Will); and, for this presentation only: Ice Cream!

--Have 2 members read the KBDM Skit.

--Count down to divide group into 6 smaller groups.

--Give each smaller group a question to consider. Tell them to be creative in their answers without going overboard. This is meant to be fun!

15 minutes:

Each group fills out the 5 KBDM questions to gather information, being sure to include something from each member of the group.

Each group fills out the KBDM Worksheet.

15 minutes:

One person from each group will read the worksheet to the entire group.

Everyone will laugh and have fun and hopefully learn about the KBDM process and how easy it is to apply it to any issue in any area of our lives (professional, play, personal).
