**Bylaws:** e Board of Trustees, in their legal capacity, approved updates to the Bylaws of Al-Anon Family Group Headquarters, Inc. and Al-Anon Family Group Headquarters (Canada) Inc. **2018 Literature Sales and Contributions:** On behalf of the Board and the Sta of our WSO, we would like to thank you for your continued generosity and support through the purchase of Conference Approved Literature (CAL) and contributions. Unaudited gross literature sales totaled \$3,975,492, which was \$375,492 above the 2018 Budget. Unaudited contributions were \$1,953,458, which was \$46,542 below budget. Overall, 2018 was still a healthy year for contributions and a record-breaking year for literature sales.

A **Safety in Al-Anon Meet**ings document drafted by WSO to aid groups in discussing and creating workable solutions to safety issues was mailed to all registered groups in December 2018. The purpose of this document is to help groups maintain Tradition One, with the understanding that our groups are not impervious to the same difficulties that affect the world around us, by discussing in advance how to address situations should they arise.

WSO sent an alert to all registered groups on the importance of discussing and creating safety guidelines. We trust the attached Safety in Al-Anon Meetings document will aid you in that process. A printed copy will be mailed to all registered Al-Anon meetings in the World Service Conference Structure in English this week. The Spanish and French translations will be mailed to meetings with these as their primary language as soon as possible in the new year.

We hope this tool will promote an environment of safety and unity throughout the groups in your Area, so they may focus on their primary purpose–to help families and friends of alcoholics.

Please note, this document applies to Al-Anon meetings, groups, events, and members: For Alateen safety, please refer to your Area Alateen Safety and Behavioral Requirements.

The WSO is currently evaluating whether to post the Safety in Al-Anon Meetings document on al-anon.org and requests that Areas not post it on their websites. Feel free to distribute print or electronic copies within the fellowship and encourage Al-Anon Family Groups in your Area to discuss safety. Please let me know it you need a copy.
