

# AWSC Fall 2020 NYNAC Coordinator Report

Due to present circumstances, the possibility of a “physical” NYNAC seems remote, and possibly irresponsible to hope for. The safety of our teens and sponsors must come first. That having been stated, the venue at Casowasco would be \$4,028.25. The cost per teen is \$148.25 (\$156.25 with t-shirt) and the cost per adult is \$169.25 (\$177.25 with t-shirt). These numbers are roughly based on 2019’s attendance numbers. (We can adjust up to two weeks before the weekend.)

Should the decision be made to have a virtual NYNAC this year, t-shirts would still be printed, but with the modified artwork. Everyone ordering a t-shirt should plan on \$11 to \$15 for the price of the t-shirt and the cost of mailing.

Planning for the eventuality of a “virtual” NYNAC is already underway. This came about as a result of an Alateen Interest meeting earlier this year.

Below are the thoughts about having a virtual meeting.

So, what do we do; how do we do it?

- Zoom NYNAC conference over the weekend with planned activities – talent show, speakers, meeting etc.
- Zoom meetings over two days with breaks in between meetings
- Use of app called Acapella for talent show. It is used by orchestras, musicians etc. for harmony and sound quality (this app might only be available on iPhones and iPads.)
- Include Alateen members in planning a virtual NYNAC. (Which is already happening.)
- It was also suggested that if we cannot have a physical NYNAC, what about moving the date back to Columbus Day weekend?

Some of the teens are already aware of this, and the word is getting out. As soon as a final decision is made about the event an email will be sent to all the groups to be passed along to the teens.




