

Service Manual or Baloney?

45 minute game

Materials:

Service Manual

Prizes:

Bologna, Cheese & Crackers

Fruit Plate

Need: Toothpicks, plastic gloves for sandwich maker, napkins, plate and knife for slicing bologna

Participants:

Emcee (draws & calls names & yells "Come on down!")

Co-Emcee (draws and reads question, calls for audience participation, tells answerer whether he/she has correct answer or not, sends that person to table for prize)

Techie (puts question up on screen in PowerPoint)

Prize Presenter (serves up bologna with cheese and crackers, fruit)

- Before the meeting, participants are reminded to bring their Service Manuals.
- Before the presentation, each participant writes his/her name on a paper and puts it in a box.

The Game:

Emcee explains the rules of the game: Contestants are chosen randomly out of the box. Contestant is asked the question; the audience helps by yelling out the answer. Contestants go to table to get prize.

- Emcee draws a name from the box, calls it out, yells "Come on down!"
- Contestant comes to front.
- Co-Emcee reads question, Techie puts question up on screen, Co-Emcee asks for audience participation.
- Contestant answers.
- Emcee says "The answer is...Service Manual!" [or]"... Baloney!" Reads the citation in the Service Manual, if applicable.
- Contestant gets bologna prize
- Prize Presenters wears plastic gloves, fixes bologna & crackers or fruit plate.
- At end of game, everyone can come to table for a snack.
