Our Delegate Reports from WSO

As Delegate, it was an honor to attend and participate in the World Service Conference (WSC) which was held April 18th-21st in Virginia Beach, VA. I want to start by expressing my gratitude for all the support I received from the groups through your cards and well wishes during the World Service Conference. The days were long and packed with so much information. It was hard work, but I enjoyed taking part in doing the business of a spiritual program. When I returned home, I had fun learning how to put a slide show presentation together and giving my Delegate's Report at the Spring Assembly. That report is available on the NYN Website on the Newsflash /AWSC and Assembly Meeting Information page (Area Events). One important piece of information to share with your groups is that the WSO cannot operate without our continued financial support. We do this through our group and individual voluntary contributions and by purchasing literature through the WSO directly, from our Al-Anon distribution centers (AIS offices & book depots), or at meetings. Each year the WSO spends \$331/group. In 2023, only 61% of groups contributed, and those groups sent in an average of \$196/year. Please share this information with your Group Treasurer and ask how much your group contributed last year. The appeal letter that is mailed to the group CMA's every quarter is a way for members to contribute directly to the WSO. Does your group share the appeal letter and give your members an opportunity to contribute?

One of the more meaningful aspects of the WSC was the manner in which we conducted business and how I was able to work my program through the process. The World Service Conference is Al-Anon's largest group conscience, guided by Tradition 2, where we invite our Higher Power to guide us in decision making. We were there to consider issues and make decisions related to finances, service roles and our operations. I noticed that when the discussion was contentious, I could feel myself becoming guarded and getting pulled into self-righteousness and closed-minded thinking. I was reminded how Tradition 6 says "lest money, property and prestige divert us from our primary spiritual aim" and I could feel it like an energy that was slowly creeping over me. My ego was showing up and I was having a hard time

shaking it. I was powerless over that feeling and no matter how much I tried, I couldn't make it go away. It took the powerful, loving kindness of my fellow delegates, during a spiritual workshop, to melt it away. I was reminded that this is a WE program; I can't do it alone. I am so grateful for this opportunity to serve Al-Anon and continue my spiritual growth. Please keep coming back.

Please Share in Writing on Sponsorship and Service Sponsorship

The 2023 World Service Conference gave conceptual approval "to develop a comprehensive piece on sponsorship and service sponsorship using personal stories from Al-Anon members." Please share your experiences with sponsorship—the benefits as well as the challenges—so we can all learn from each other how to effectively use these important recovery tools.

Please consider answering any of the following questions:

- How soon did I get a Sponsor? Become a Sponsor?
- What, if anything, has kept me from finding or becoming a Sponsor?
- What qualities do I look for in a Sponsor?
- What impact has having or being a Sponsor had on my recovery?
- Were the parameters of my sponsorship relationship a good fit for both of us?
- Have I studied the Steps, Traditions, or Concepts of Service with a Sponsor or someone I sponsor?
- What have I learned from having or being a Sponsor?
- What did I do if my needs were not being met by having or being a Sponsor?
- Which of Al-Anon's spiritual principles apply to having or being a Sponsor?

- Why do (or don't) I have a Service Sponsor? Why am (or aren't) I a Service Sponsor?
- How is my Service Sponsor different from my personal Sponsor?
- How am I different as a Service Sponsor than as a personal Sponsor?
- Which of Al-Anon's spiritual principles apply to having or being a Service Sponsor?

Please keep the following guidelines in mind:

- Share personal experience from the heart, focusing on yourself, not the alcoholic or others.
- Write in the first person singular—"I." Please avoid the use of the pronoun "you."
- Avoid generalities, outside issues, treatment center language, and religious philosophy or doctrine.
- Kindly observe Al-Anon's Twelve Traditions when sharing.

If printed, your sharing will remain anonymous, but please include your name and postal or email address so that we can acknowledge receipt.

If not used, your sharing will be forwarded to the *Forum* Editorial Advisory Committee for review. If published in *The Forum*, you will be notified by letter and receive a complimentary copy of the issue in which your article appears.

This Month's Topic

KEEP COMING BACK!

Our theme for this month is "Keep Coming Back." I had heard that slogan at my very first Al-Anon meeting and, encouraged by the fact that I felt welcomed in that group, I did come back the next week to my second meeting. Gradually I went to 2, 3, 4 and more meetings a week in my first year of recovery, and I felt welcomed at each one.

Over the time that I have been in Al-Anon I have noticed that some members start attending Al-Anon and come for a while and then stop coming. I always wondered why, since Al-Anon had saved my life. I had felt the program was working for me.

Well, after I had been in Al-Anon for about 16 years, many of those in Al-Anon and Alateen service, I had a midlife crisis of sorts due to some local personality issues in Al-Anon service, and I did not feel safe in these rooms anymore. I contemplated quitting Al-Anon, but I was hesitant to do so because I had seen so many members leave Al-Anon over the years and most of those members never came back.

I did not want to be one of them so I kept going to meetings and doubled down on working with my sponsor, and gradually my fear faded away and now after 34 years of active membership I am very glad that I stayed.
