NOTE: Version 4 of the <u>Service Manual</u> is now available on line: <u>Al-Anon Alateen Service Manual (P-24/27) - Al-Anon Family Groups</u>. For those with Printed Version 2 Manuals, replacement pages of the updates are also available: <u>P2427-v4-replacement-pages.pdf (al-anon.org)</u>. Members with physical manuals can download the replacement pages, print them and post them into their physical books so their books will be up to date.

The Printed Version is the 2022 - 2025 Edition. They only make updates and publish a new physical copy every 4 years. So, the printed version is Version 2, but the most up-to-date version is Version 4, available on line only.

News from the WSO from the Area Delegate - Carrying the Guidance from the Widest Perspective

Here are the highlights of the Chairperson of the Board Letter from the July Board of Trustees (BOT) meeting (the letter and finance committee and policy committee updates are available in my report on the area website at https:nynafg.com/news.html):

Glossary: AFG= Al-Anon Family Groups

BOT=Board of Trustees

WSC=World Service Conference (made up of delgates

- The October Board of Trustees meeting <u>Road Trip! You and Your Board Connect</u>, will be held in Columbia, SC on Oct 26th, 9-5. This meeting is open to all Al-Anon members. Registration is required and costs \$30. This is an opportunity to: meet the WSO Volunteers who have oversight of AFG, Inc. (Board of Trustees, the Executive Committee, and several WSO Staff members) understand the committees on which they serve and how the WSC Structure works. There will be personal shares, panels, interactive sessions, lunch, and snacks. For details and to register go the www.al-anon.org click on Calendar then WSO Events and Road Trip 2024 South Carolina.
- The Executive Director shared important guidance regarding **Artificial Intelligence (AI).** WSO Staff and Volunteers were asked not to use any AI tools unless licensed by AFG, Inc. This includes transcription features for web conference meetings. This approach is designed to protect personally identifiable information and the confidential nature of our meetings. The WSO staff will continue its investigation into how to safely utilize the technology to improve efficiency while protecting our fellowship from harm.
- The 2024 World Service Conference (WSC) approved a motion from the Policy Committee to update the Service Manual with <u>new language regarding group names</u>. As a result of this new policy, the WSO will now only register new groups and update existing group names when their name does not contain community-identifying designations (such as Women, Men, Parents, Adult Children, LGTBQ+, People of Color). *Groups who currently have names containing community-identifying designations are asked to consider removing the designations from their names and using the "participants/attendees" field for community identification.*
- The BOT approved a revised **budget** that is projecting a \$197,860 surplus.
- The BOT approved the amounts for the Equalized Expense and the Full <u>Cost for Delegates</u> to attend the 2025 WSC in NYN (these amounts are included in the Treasurer's Report).
- The BOT voted to **end the four-day WSC** week trial and return to hosting the WSC across five days beginning with the 2026 WSC.
- The BOT approved a six-year trial starting after the 2025 WSC to hold **the WSC in the NY area** once every three years to allow for the Conference members to attend **Stepping Stones** once during their panel.
- The BOT confirmed that the <u>2025 WSC</u> will be held Thurs April 24th Sunday, April 27th at the Marriott Hartford/Windsor Airport Hotel, Windsor, CT. The Stepping Stones visit will occur Monday, April 28th.
- Open Position at the WSO for an <u>International Specialist</u>: to be eligible you must be an Active member of Al-Anon for the last five or more years, have service experience beyond the group level and be passionate about Al-Anon service and carrying the message. **Are you that member?**See the position description for a summary of the job duties and position requirements posted with my report on the area website (www.nynafg.com). A Recap of Decisions That Were Made at the Fall Assembly:

- The 2025 Budget of \$25,950 was approved. (For details please go to the NYN Area website www.nynafg.com under the NYN NewsFlash / AWSC and Assembly Meeting Information page and click on the Proposed Budget under the Treasurer's Report).
- 2. A motion to pay the "Total Cost" of \$3,617.71 for the Delegate to attend the 2025 WSC was approved.
- 3. The Area was not able to reach a consensus on a donation to the WSO.
- 4. A motion to accept Electronic Groups into the NYN Service Structure was approved.
- 5. A motion to add to the NYN Policies a Procedure to Accept Electronic Groups was approved. (Insert Policy here or where to find it)
- 6. It was recommended by the Technology Thought Force to create a new area service position for a Technology Coordinator. A task force was approved to draft a Position Description for a Technology Coordinator. If you are interested in serving on this task force, please contact Ellen V, the Area Chairperson by emailing Chairperson@nynafg.com.
- 7. Molly C. was voted in to serve as Area Secretary for the remainder of Panel 64 (term ends Dec 31, 2026).
- 8. Maria S. was voted in to serve as Web Coordinator for the remainder of Panel 64 (ends Dec 31, 2026).
- 9. Jenna E. was voted in to serve as Public Outreach Coordinator for the remainder of Panel 64 (term ends Dec 31, 2026).
- 10. The Alateen Coordinator position remains vacant. Please consider serving in this position (must be a certified AMIAS).
- 11. A consensus was reached to establish a NYN Area Policy Task Force to review, update and organize the policies together in a single document and possibly change them for better understanding and alignment with WSO.






This Month's Topic
