Our Delegate Requests your Input for the 2025 WSC Conference Agenda Item (CAI)

Is there a topic of concern that affects Al-Anon groups and members worldwide that you would like the World Service Conference to discuss in depth? All Conference members (Delegates, Trustees and WSO Staff) are invited to submit a topic to be considered for discussion at the World Service Conference. They are placed on the agenda as a Chosen Agenda Item (CAI). Next year's WSC will have two Chosen Agenda Items to be discussed.

Did you know that the summaries of all Conference Agenda Items are available to read on the Al-Anon.org website? Go to (Chosen Agenda Items - Al-Anon Family Groups) the Al-Anon.org website, click on Members, then in the drop-down menu click on World Service Conference. The next drop-down menu will contain the Conference Agenda Items. Click on that and go exploring.

As your Delegate, I can submit one or two topics to be considered for discussion at the 2025 World Service Conference. *I need your input*. As you think about topics, please consider whether the topic merits an in-depth discussion that could benefit Al-Anon groups and members worldwide.

Topics are limited to 100 words: name the topic (25 words or less); then provide a rationale / explanation of why you think the topic is important (75 words or less).

Send your topic for consideration to me at chairperson@nynafg.com by **January 17th**. I will select one or two topics to submit and topics I submit will be combined with those from all the other Conference members. Two topics will be chosen. If you would like to see examples of past CAIs, you can go to Al-Anon. org and look at past World Service Conference Summaries.

News From the WSO October Board of Trustees Meeting:

On Nov 9th, I attended a presentation of the Letter from the Chairperson of the Board. This letter summarizes the October Board of Trustees meeting. Here are bullet points from the presentation:

 Conversation about perception – The Board concluded that by choosing to serve at the world service level, WSO Volunteers agree to place the needs of AFG above our personal preferences when sharing information at the level of press, radio, film, TV and internet, including social media. Our conversation helped us to recognize that when we share personal opinions on social media—even if those opinions involve outside issues—those who know us as WSO Volunteers may perceive those opinions as reflecting the choices or voice of AFG, Inc.

- The GEA Regional Assignment- The Board decided to extent for a second three-year period the trial to assign the GEA to the Region within the WSC Structure in which their current Delegate lives or, if the Delegate lives outside the WSC Structure, to a WSC Structure Region pulled from a hat.
- Reserve Fund and WSO's One Year's Operation Expense- Cost information was provided for the following projects to be financed by the excess funds in the Reserve Fund: Core Systems Overhaul (electronic systems), Passing It On (growing leaders from interactions with past volunteers), Public Outreach Campaign for the Professional: Young People. Timing for completing these special projects will be considered as part of the Board's Jan 2025 Strategies approval process.
- Events The 2028 International Convention Site Selection will be announced at the 2025 WSC. Road Trip! 2025 location will be revealed in January.

• Nominating Committee

The Board approved a proposed role description for the At-Large Executive Committee. The Board accepted the Nominating Committee's recommendation that Delegates not be required to wait two years after serving before being considered to serve as an At-Large member of the Executive Committee.

• International Coordination Committee (ICC) Russia and Austria were recommended and accepted as new admissions to the IAGSM. A Thought Force was created to investigate alternate funding options for future IAGSMs. If you would like more information or details of the presentation of the Chairperson of the Board Letter, please send me an email (at Delegate@nynafg.com) and I'll be happy to review it with you.

Rooms at the RIT Inn and Conference Center in Henrietta, NY located at 5257 W Henrietta Rd, Henrietta, NY 14670. Rooms will be \$129/double + tax = \$148 per night. The last day to obtain this room rate will be May 1, 2025, and you can reserve a room by calling the hotel directly - 585-359-1800. Please reserve your room under the name "NYNAFG."

Registration opens online at nynafg.com on January 1, 2025. Early bird registration will be \$35 for the weekend; after May 1 2025, registration goes up to \$40. Registration is also available by mail by using the form printed on page 4. Registration for Alateen members will be \$10.00. Please Note: ANY Alateen member attending any function carrying the Al-Anon/Alateen name must be accompanied by a parent or NYN Certified Al-Anon Member involved in Alateen Service (AMIAS), and a notarized Permission/Medical form is required. That form is available from the NYN Area Alateen Coordinator at alateen@nynafg.com.

There will be a hospitality room and various raffles. Conference Approved Literature will be for sale (provided by the Rochester AIS).

A boxed lunch will be offered on Saturday, May 31, 2024 for \$20 (wrap, chips, beverage and cookie or fruit). There are also restaurants nearby. On Saturday, May 31, 2025 there will be a Deluxe Buffet Dinner for \$45, (two entrees, vegetable, salad, hot drinks, warm rolls, and cake). Buffet Dinner reservations will need to be pre-registered before May 1, 2025.

The remaining Assemblies for NYN Panel 64 will consist of the 2025 Fall Assembly, the 2026 Spring Assembly, and finally the 2026 Fall Election Assembly. It is not too early for districts who are willing to host the 2026 Fall Election Assembly to step forward, and to start searching for a hotel or other venue to hold it.
